Benefits

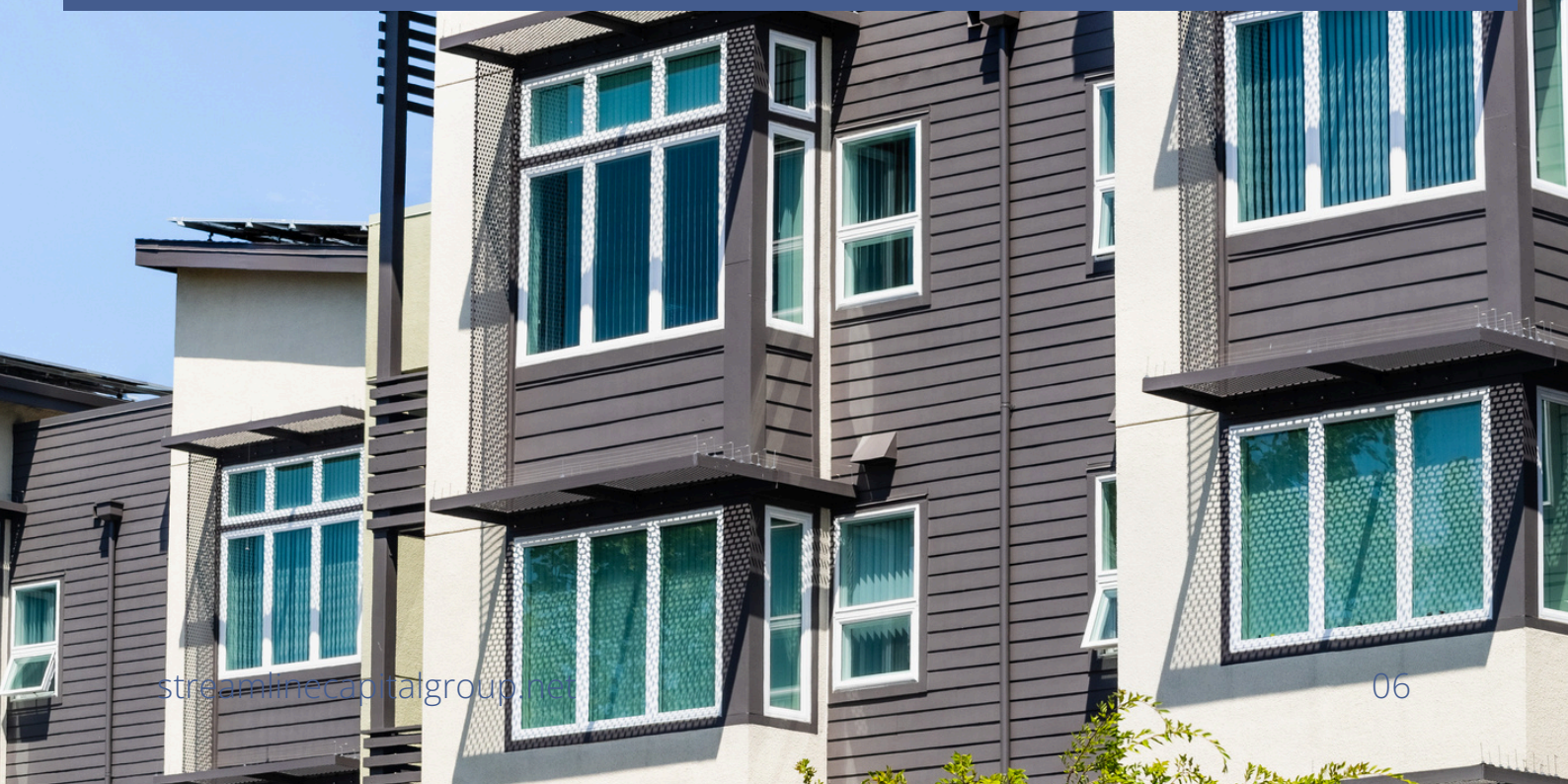

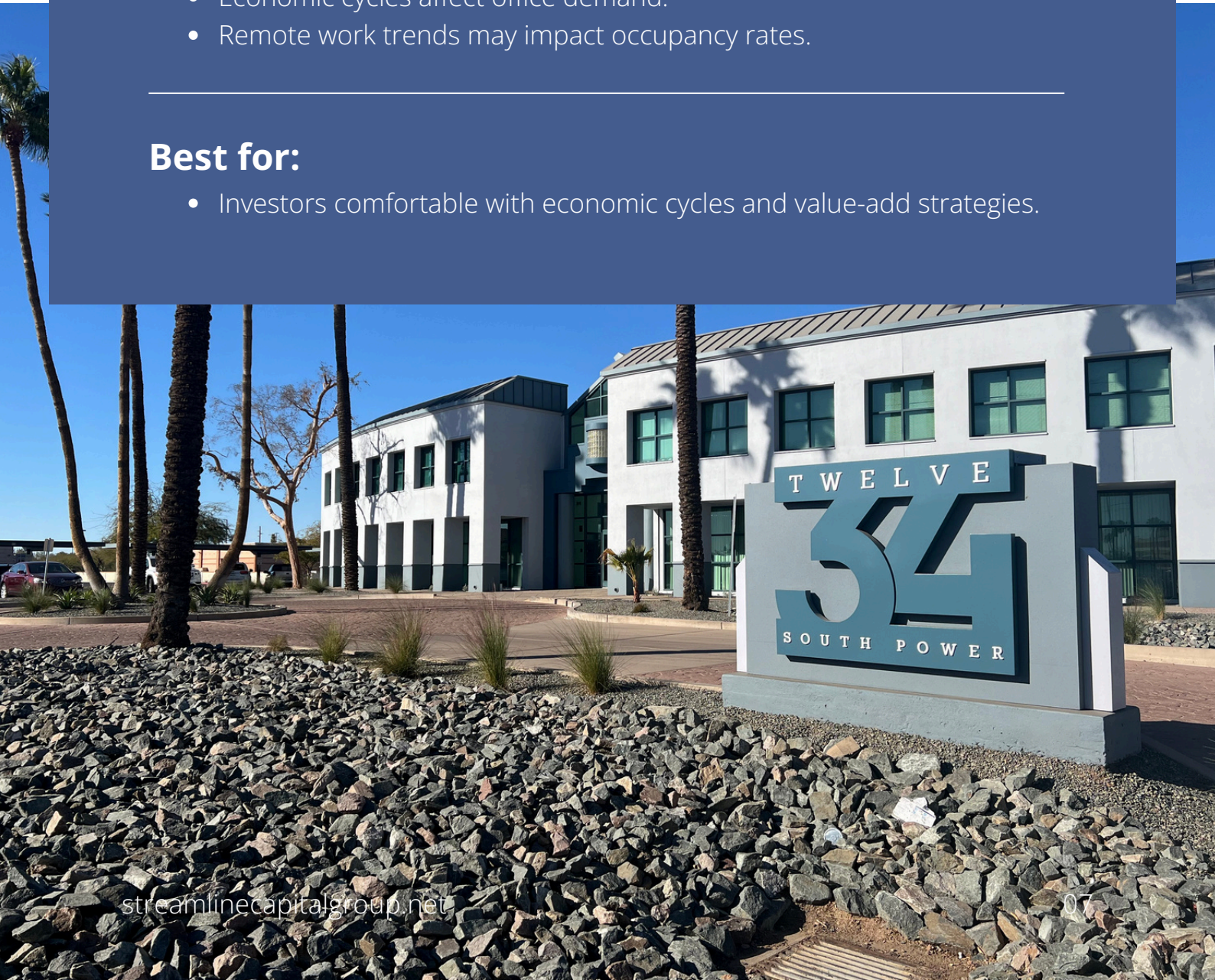
